Setup Method

Chapter 1 General Principles

Article 1 These regulations are formulated on the establishment and abolition of the National Sun Yat-sen University Research Center.

Article 2 The center is named " Water Resources Studies of National Sun Yat-sen University " (hereinafter referred to as the center). This organization is a first-level center of the school.

Article 3 The subjects:

1. Engaging in academic research on water resources technology and policy.
2. Promoting water resources education and correct the conception of water resources management, conservation for the public.
3. Collecting existing national water resources and establish an information network to make the center be the most important database of water resources.
4. Strengthening inter-faculty and cross-discipline water resources research within our school, enhance cooperation between our school and other colleges to promote water resources research, education and information management.

Article 4 The projects:

1. Engaging in special research projects on water resources technology and policy.
2. Assisting to hold the seminars and public forum activities of water resources science and technology.

3. Offering workshops and training related to water resources science and policy.
4. Publication of monographs or academic journals on water resources science and policy.
5. Promoting inter-institution cooperation in water resources research.

Article 5 The center is a cross-disciplinary property, so according to the needs of plan or activities. Need to combine with the professional manpower and equipment of the relevant departments of the school, we can cooperate and participate in mutual support.

Chapter II Organization and Responsibility

Article 6 Due to business needs, the center has some groups and the duties of each sections are as follows:

1. Legal and Political Section:
Engaged in research on laws and policies related to water resources issues.
2. Planning Section:
Engaged in research on industrial development and regional planning related to water resources issues.
3. Ecology Section:
Engaged in research on ecological, soil and water conservation, also forest management related to water resources issues.
4. Science and Technology Section:
Engaged in technology and information research related to water resources issues.
5. Social Section:
Engaged in research on public-private sector interaction and education promotion related to water resources issues.

Chapter III Preparation and Budget

Article 7 The center has one director, who comprehensively manage the business, and be hired by the principal. Also, who is the professor (researcher) water resources technology and policy related fields of the school, for three years or may be re-elected.

Article 8 The center also need a secretary to take the orders of the director to promote and execute the various services.

Article 9 Each section of the center has one team leader, and the principal is recommended by the director to hire assistant professors (assistant researchers) or above from teachers (researchers).

Article 10 The funds of the center are covered by self-raised or accepting entrustment, subsidies, donations, etc. To maintain a balance of income and expenditure or having a surplus. All income should be included in the administrative fund of the school. Also, the reporting and various funds shall be handled in the regulations of school.

Article 11 The staff of the center who are part-time/full-time teachers or researchers are not given their posts; but those who have a budget due to entrustment, subsidies, etc., can be dealt with under the budget in accordance with the project contract and related regulations.

Chapter IV Supplementary Provisions

Article 12 The center must be evaluated by the school, and the evaluation items and methods shall be handled in relevant regulations.

Article 13 If the duty is fulfilled, the director of the center must apply for the abolition through a resolution conference.

Article 14 This method was approved by the meeting of the center and asked the principal to implement it after approval. The amendment is also the same.
